

# SCHOOL FIGHT IN BETHEL GOES MERRILY ON

The fight to prevent the erection of a new high school building in Bethel township may result in a split and the forming of two special school districts. If this should be the outcome of the injunction suit filed against the directors of the school one of the best school systems in the county will be ruined, as Bethel township is noted as being the third richest school district in Clark county.

The dissension in the township was caused by the fact that the school board had advertised for bids for the erection of a high school to cost \$12,000 and the calm was made by those opposing the plan that the building was not needed and that the present building is adequate for some time to come. On the day that the bids were to be opened the opposition filed injunction proceedings in the local common pleas court with the result that a temporary restraining order was issued.

It is now said that the plan of those opposing the erection of the building is to delay the matter until the next election when the members of the board who favor the new school will be defeated if they stand for re-election.
