

Olive Branch Preservation Committee

The last “old” building left in the district is Olive Branch School. Olive Branch was originally built in 1908 and burned down in a fire that started in the boiler room in 1913. The building was rebuilt on the original foundation. Currently the building is being used as a district warehouse.

A committee has been formed to explore funding sources to renovate the old Olive Branch School. The committee is in the process of applying for the building’s inclusion on the National Registry of Historic Places and once the process is completed grant money, fund raising, donations, and other options will be pursued.
