

OBSPS Plans Open House

The Olive Branch School Preservation Society Board of Trustees extends an invitation to all New Carlisle, Bethel Township, and surrounding Clark County community residents to attend an Open House and Sign unveiling from 2:00-4:00 p.m. on Sunday November 4 at the Olive Branch School as we launch Phase 1 (asbestos removal) restoration project of

this historic building.

Olive Branch is located just east of Tecumseh High School near the school bus compound. The “Little Round Building or Rotunda Building,” as it is sometimes referred to, was constructed in 1908, destroyed by fire in 1913, rebuilt in 1914, and opened to students once again in January of 1915. It continued to house and educate students until

1972. The building has been utilized as a warehouse and storage facility by the School District for the last forty years. Even though the building is still in use as a warehouse and storage facility, the public will have the opportunity to walk through and discover the uniqueness of the interior of this one-of-a-kind school building.
